TYRONE HARRIS WAS BORN TO ROBERT & SWEETIE MARIE HARRIS ON MAY 1, 1948. HE WAS THE FOURTH CHILD OF SIX CHILDREN. AT AN EARLY AGE HE ACCEPT CHRIST AND UNITED WITH NEW SALEM BAPTIST CHURCH UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF REV. CHARLES H. WALKER WHERE HE WAS BAPTIZED.
